NSSGA Aglime Forum

Stoneco Recently attended the National Stone Sand & Gravel Association Aglime Forum in Urbana, IL. The meeting included suppliers, vendors, and experts in the field of aglime. Some interesting facts were touched on, some of which are listed below.

pH is the most important soil chemical property, aglime is a way to control that.

There is no real difference between Dolomitic lime and Calacitic lime for the purpose of controlling pH levels in the soil. - Mr. Robert Hoeft, Member the American Society of Agronomy, President Department of Crop Sciences University of Illinois.

The three essential principles in value added liming include quality, location, and cost. Stoneco has consistently met these principles and currently has aglime available at our Stoneco Maybee and Stoneco Ottawa lake locations.
