#### **U.S. 2008 Tornado Death Toll 60% Above Average**

Spring is typically the start of tornado season, with 106 deaths already recorded this is the deadliest year since 1998, and is on pace to be the deadliest ever recorded. Stoneco employees are trained on how to deal with severe weather at all facilities. Employees may ask customers to seek shelter in case of severe weather. If the customer refuses to seek shelter they may be asked to leave the facility until the severe weather leaves the area. The contingency plans in place at our sites are used to keep everyone on site as safe as possible. Thank you for your cooperation.



## Denniston Update

Beginning Monday, June 30, the Denniston location will be open 7:00a.m.- 4:00p.m. Monday through Friday. We will not be producing material at Denniston so 6AA Commercial will be available at our Maybee location and MDOT 6AA will be available at our Newport location. We will still have MDOT 26A, 21AA Commercial, Screenings and 1x3 available at Denniston.

A short distance off I-94 the Stoneco Zeeb Road Gravel Pit is ideally located to service your sand and crushed gravel needs. They carry multiple sizes of crushed gravel, pea-stone and multiple sand gradations.

## New & Exciting

We can custom crush any size of armor stone you need for your projects at the Maybee and Ottawa Lake Quarries. While we stock MDOT Plain and MDOT Heavy Rip Rap we typically have a small supply of three to four foot Armor Stone on hand at either of these locations. With a few days notice we can make any size from eight inches to five feet.

## Checking In

At the Maybee, Ottawa Lake, Zeeb Road and Denniston locations we have the JWS Auto-ID swipe card system in place at our scales. The system is designed so that when a driver arrives at one of these locations they use a swipe card at one of the check in points. The swipe cards are about the size of a driver's license and are waved in front of an electronic reader that identifies each truck. At Maybee and Ottawa Lake the readers are located on the inbound scale, at Zeeb Road and Denniston the readers are located away from the scale as these locations do not have a specified inbound only scale. At the first check in of each day the driver must contact the scale house and let our scale clerks know who is being charged for the material, what material they are getting, and what project or location the material needs to be assigned to. After that point the only communication with our scales that is necessary is if any of this information is being changed.
