Stand Down For Safety

Controlling Quality

We have full time quality control department that consists of a quality control manager and three quality control technicians. Our Quality Control Department tests and evaluates all of the aggregate we produce at all of our operations to ensure that we are shipping a quality material. They use the AgQc Database that tracks this information and helps ensure the quality of the aggregates we sell. That test data is available by fax or email should you ever have a questions on any of our materials.

MDOT – Pre Certified

All of our quarries and the Zeeb Road Sand and Gravel pit are MDOT Pre-Certified pits, which means these locations meet standards set forth by the Michigan Department of Transportation for quality. These products include 6AA, Coarse Aggregate, 21AA, 22A, 23A, Plain Rip Rap, Class II Sand, 26A, 17A, Heavy Rip Rap, and many other products. Not a Dump Site

Occasionally at some of our sites we are able to accommodate loads of clean fill material. We have always asked that we be notified prior to any such dumping and that the proper protocols are being followed.
