 Haul Route Limits: Zeeb Road, between 2670 S. Zeeb Road (MDOT Pit #81-092) and Park Road, approximately 2.2 miles. Permit holder is responsible for all hauling operations to and from its source, and shall use the designated haul route. This permit will not be valid for overweight vehicles or loads during Springtime Weight Restrictions or during any other time as determined by the Road Commission. Maximum allowable width is 102", including load. Axle and wheel loadings limited to designated loading maximums as defined on the current WCRC truck operator's map.

CONDITIONS OF PERMIT

SUPPLEMENTAL SPECIFICATIONS: The supplemental specifications appearing on the back of the application for this permit, copy attached, and other attached supplemental specifications are herein incorporated as part of the permit.

- 1. Accident Liability and Indemnification: The Permit Holder shall pay for all damages, fines and penalties for which it shall become liable and shall save harmless and indemnify the Washtenaw County Road Commission against all suits, claims, damages, and proceedings of any kind arising from work attributable to hauling operations on public roads.
- 2. Guarantees: Upon demand by the Board, the Permit Holder shall, before, or at anytime during operations, furnish an irrevocable bank letter of credit in an amount deemed necessary by the Board to cover damage to said roads. It is understood that the Permit Holder is responsible for the conditions of said roads during the operations permitted hereunder, and for the performance of the conditions of said guarantee, and that all work on said roads will be at the discretion of the Board. If the cost of work exceeds the amount of said guarantee, the Permit Holder shall be liable for any deficiency. The Permit Holder shall be responsible for any damage to said roads as determined by the Road Commission to be attributed to hauling operations. The Permit Holder shall keep letters of credit in effect until released by the Board.
- 3. <u>Precautions:</u> During construction within the limits of the designated haul route, the Permit Holder shall provide all barricades, signs, lights, and flag persons as may be required for the safety and convenience of the public in accordance with the current Michigan Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices. Traffic shall be maintained at all times unless otherwise indicated hereon by special endorsement of the Board's duly authorized representative.
- 4. <u>Violations:</u> The violation of any conditions of the permit by the Permit Holder or its material haulers shall constitute a forfeiture of all privileges granted hereunder. In the event that public health, safety, and welfare is jeopardized, the Board grants the Managing Director the authority to revoke the permit on a temporary basis until the next scheduled Board Meeting.
- 5. Permit Revocable: It is distinctly understood that the privileges granted herein are revocable at the will of the Board, and that the Permit Holder shall have no rights in any of said roads, and expressly waives any right to claim damages or compensation of any kind in case the permit is revoked. The Permit Holder will be notified of its right to appear before the Board at the meeting that revocation of the permit is considered.
